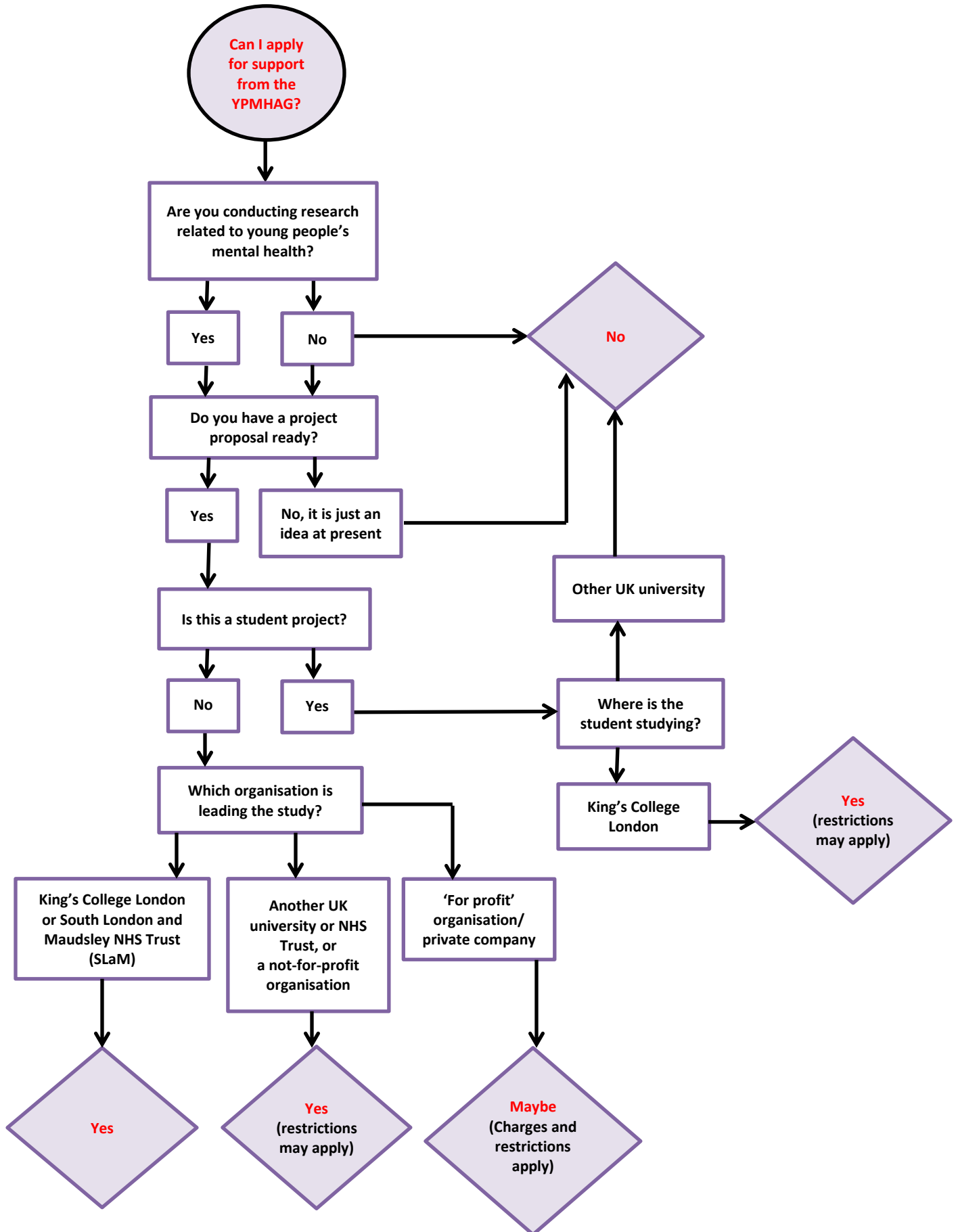


# Accessing the Young Person’s Mental Health Advisory Group (YPMHAG)



## Requesting a slot

To request a slot at a meeting, please complete the online [survey](#). Your request will be considered by our team and we will respond within seven days to confirm whether we can offer you a slot.

If you are offered a slot, we will ask you to confirm attendance in writing (meetings are always held on Saturdays in Central London).

We will also contact you a week before the meeting date. The purpose of this is to check that you are still coming (so that we can offer your slot to others if not). Please notify us in advance if you do not intend to come, giving at least one week's notice. We will not offer you another slot if you miss a meeting without giving notice (unless there are extenuating circumstances).

## I have visited the group once for the same project, can I come visit the group again?

Potentially yes, but your project will be considered lower priority than a project which has not been seen by the group already. We only offer a maximum of two visits per project, so you might want to think about when would be best to have input. For those who are wanting continued Patient and Carer Involvement and Engagement (PCIE) support for projects, we can provide advice on how to develop a PCIE strategy into your own project.

## My research project is being undertaken by a 'for profit' company, what does this mean?

Private companies will be charged for using the group. The cost of the appointment will vary considering the length of the slot. Please contact us for further information.
